### 1) Board of Health Orientation (Decision):

We have developed a Board of Health orientation plan for 2023. Of note, we had originally planned for Orientation sessions to begin in late 2022, but with the pending municipal election and with board meetings being held on an ad hoc basis, we felt that restarting the sessions in the new year was the best course of action.

The orientation plan includes a variety of subjects ranging from the role of public health, a deep dive into our programs and services, an overview of SWPH's After Action Review of the COVID-19 pandemic, and a visioning session that works on having a cohesive aim and understanding expectations of all. The latter session will be a facilitated session with the help of a consultant familiar with SWPH. Each orientation session will include a presentation and generous amount of time for generative discussion.

The goal of this orientation plan is to ensure all Board Members, with varying degrees of public health knowledge, will have a common understanding of SWPH's work, will be well positioned to govern with the right information at the right time, and will have clear expectations of each other and of the CEO and the Medical Officer of Health.

### 2) Committee Workplan for 2023 (Decision):

Attached is the 2023 workplan for the Committee to review and recommend approval to the Board.

The workplan does not have proposed meeting dates because there will be a change in Chair and new Committee members following the 2023 Board of Health appointments. The Committee will be canvased in the new year once a new Board of Health and Standing Committees have been formed.
